Positive and exemplary sportsmanship and appropriate demeanor by everyone.

Safety and well-being of players, coaches, umpires, and spectators.

First-class representation of players, parents/families, coaches, umpires, and spectators.

Full respect and pride for the presentation of our Flag, Pledge of Allegiance, and National Anthem.

Always playing within the established rules of the game.

The understanding that participation with the DALEVILLE JUNIOR BASEBALL & SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION is a privilege and a player/family decision, completely voluntary.

Comply with team dress code, appearance, and player uniform standards.

Realization that all of our activities (instructional and competitive) are designed to enhance growth and development of all our players, families, and coaches.

Equal respect and value of every teammate regardless of size, experience, talent, or performance...no criticism or "looking down on" anyone in any manner at any time for any reason whatsoever.

Coaches decisions (...whether we understand, like, or agree with them!)...and, no "coaching" from the stands.

Encouragement of everyone involved... players, coaches, parents, family members, etc.

The reality that some players may have more plate appearances, playing time, positions/roles, and starting assignments, than other players.

Tactful, quiet, one-on-one discussions of any concerns, questions, or ideas with coaches and umpires.

Importance of leaving each dugout, each ball park, each tournament site, and each situation in better shape than we found them.

## Daleville Junior Baseball & Softball Association ZERO-TOLERANCE POLICY

Throwing of equipment (helmet, bat, etc.) WILL NOT BE TOLERATED

Profanity WILL NOT BE TOLERATED

The use of any Tobacco products or Alcohol WILL NOT BE TOLERATED

Verbal abuse of umpires, coaches, players, and spectators WILL NOT BE TOLERATED Fighting WILL NOT BE TOLERATED

Vandalism WILL NOT BE TOLERATED

Any player, coach or spectator who violates the Code of Conduct during a game is subject to ejection from that game by an Umpire or any Officer/Board member present.

Anyone ejected from game is required, immediately to leave the Daleville Junior Baseball & Softball Association property.

Any player, coach or spectator who is ejected from a game shall be suspended from their next game. This also includes suspensions at "away" games and practices.

Any ejection due to a violation of the Code of Conduct may be referred to the DALEVILLE JUNIOR BASEBALL & SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION Board for review and possible further sanctions, including and up to, removal from the League.
